Subject: Interpretation on Bench Crossbow Support Question

The Technical Committee has received the following request:

“Is it legal to just support the front of the crossbow instead of supporting both the front and rear in a bench rest?”

It is the opinion of the Technical Committee:

“That when shooting from a bench/table it is NOT legal to support only the front of the crossbow on a stand.”

Under the present rules as listed in rule 42.9.1 (B) a crossbow shot from a bench must be supported front and rear on supports which sit on the bench.

It is also the view of the Technical Committee that as this is a new type of shoot, it needs to be given time to settle down before any rule changes are made.
