The format for the 2012 National Indoor Championships has been changed to provide greater variety for all competitors.

The format will be 1 x FITA Indoor 1 Round (60 arrows at 18m) and 2 x Australian Indoor 1 Rounds (2 x 30 arrows at 18m)

The Australian Indoor 1 Rounds will be shot to Las Vegas Rules, all competitors irrespective of equipment will shoot the full ten ring, the X ring will only be used as an X.

Open World Indoor Crossbow Championships**

Timing: WA – Woodanilling Rec. Centre - 121/22nd July 2012

Conditions of Entry:

1 x TC600/40 Indoor Round comprising 60 competition bolts at 18m on 40 cm treble or strip multi-coloured or black and yellow faces with 5 scoring zones from 6 to 10 only (HiVis V=KRS); and;

and 1 x TC600/25 Indoor Round comprising 60 competition bolts at 18m on 25 cm treble or strip multi—coloured or black and yellow strip face with 7 scoring zones from 4 to 10 only. (These faces may be down-loaded from WCSA website – HiVis Version 2) or are available by request from Secretary General).

Rounds may be shot on different days or the same day.

There will be both Individual and Teams competition for both Target and Sport crossbow.

Each Federation may enter up to four (4) teams in each of Men, Women, Seniors, Junior and Assisted classes. Each team will comprise three (3) shooters. There can be no Matchplay competition.

Rounds should preferably be shot in conjunction with a National, Regional or major championship shot under WCSA rules. All Tournaments must be registered as WCSA STAR EVENTS prior to competition starting and be listed on the WCSA shooting calendar.

Entry is open to all WCSA affiliated federations and clubs covering both the Target and Sport crossbow divisions for Men, Women, Seniors, Juniors (Under 18 years), and Assisted categories.

Please use the official score sheets as attached. Score sheets must be signed and witnessed and certified by both the Director of Shooting and federation or club official. Scores may be shot in any registered event.

Awards: Gold, silver and bronze WCSA medals in each class for both Individual and Team competition.

WCSA Star badges may be claimed via your federation Secretary

Completed scoresheets should be posted by AIRMAIL to reach the WCSA Secretary General together with all monies post-marked not later than 30 September 2008
