ENTRIES and PAYMENT

Entries close on **1 March 2016**.

Entries withdrawn up to **27 March 2016** will be refunded, less 25% of the fees paid.

Total Entry Fees must accompany the entry form, unless special arrangements are made with the Organising Committee (for example overseas entrants).

LATE ENTRIES

Late entries will only be accepted up to **20 March 2016** by and at the discretion of the Organising Committee and are subject to the availability of shooting positions. A late entry fee of \$20 is applicable.

No entries will be accepted after 27 March 2016.

ENTRIES

All competitors must complete the Entry Form together with the ARCHERY AUSTRALIA Photographic/Media Consent Form and forward them with the appropriate Entry Fees.

Junior competitors who will not have an accompanying parent/guardian must complete an ARCHERY AUSTRALIA Parent/Guardian Medical Consent Form and attach it with the entry form.

LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

All entrants must have a current Archery Australia or Archery Alliance and or World Crossbow Shooting Association membership. It is the competitor's responsibility to comply with all State, National and Australian legal requirements for possession, use and importation of their crossbow.

ACCOMMODATION

It is the competitor's responsibility to arrange and pay for accommodation and meals.

APPEALS

A \$25 Appeal fee applies to each appeal and is required to be paid on the lodgement of the appeal. If the appeal is successful, the fee will be refunded. If the appeal is unsuccessful, the fee will be retained by the Organising Committee or refunded at its discretion.

CATERING

Lunches will be available at the venue and need to be ordered before the start of competition each day. If not ordered by this time, lunches cannot be guaranteed. Order forms will be provided at registration. Snacks, drinks, etc will be available during competition.

DRESS REGULATIONS

In order to present the best possible image for our sport, to our sponsors and to the general public, the Organising Committee will be enforcing ARCHERY AUSTRALIA Rules (7.10) in respect of athletes dress. Please note that WCSA Rule 35 (Clothing) must be adhered to.

MEDALS

Medals will be awarded in accordance with the ARCHERY AUSTRALIA Rules (3.1.6). These will be awarded and presented at the venues on completion of the event.

Visitor medals will be awarded for all non-Association placegetters.

PRACTICE

Unofficial practice will be available on days prior to the competition at the Archery Road venue.

Competitors wishing to practice on days prior to Official Practice need to advise the organising committee prior to their arrival.

Dinner

On Sunday evening we will hold a dinner at a local restaurant. Each person will pay for what they order.

RESULTS

The results will be distributed at the Presentation and also be published on the ARCHERY AUSTRALIA website (www.archery.org.au) Those looking for results should be aware that because of the location of the events, publication of daily results on the website may take up to 24 hours.

TRANSPORT

Transport arrangements are the responsibility of entrants. The Barossa Archery Club is located in Tanunda in the Barossa Valley approx 1 - 1/1/2 hours drive from the Adelaide airport. There is no public transport between Adelaide and Tanunda.

Competition rounds

TC900.

- 90 bolts with 30 bolts shot at each of 65m, 55m & 45m on a 60cm face.
- Ends of 3 bolts are shot in 3 minutes.
- Practice: 2 ends of 3 bolts in five minutes at the start of the day and 1 end of 3 bolts in 5 minutes at the beginning of each distance.

SC600.

- 60 bolts with 20 bolts at each of 55m, 45m & 35m on a 60cm face.
- Ends of 2 bolts are shot in 3 minutes.
- Practice: 2 ends of 2 bolts in five minutes at the start of the day and 1 end of 2 bolts in five minutes at the beginning of each distance.

Day 1 distances shot - longest to shortest. Day 2 distances shot - shortest to longest.

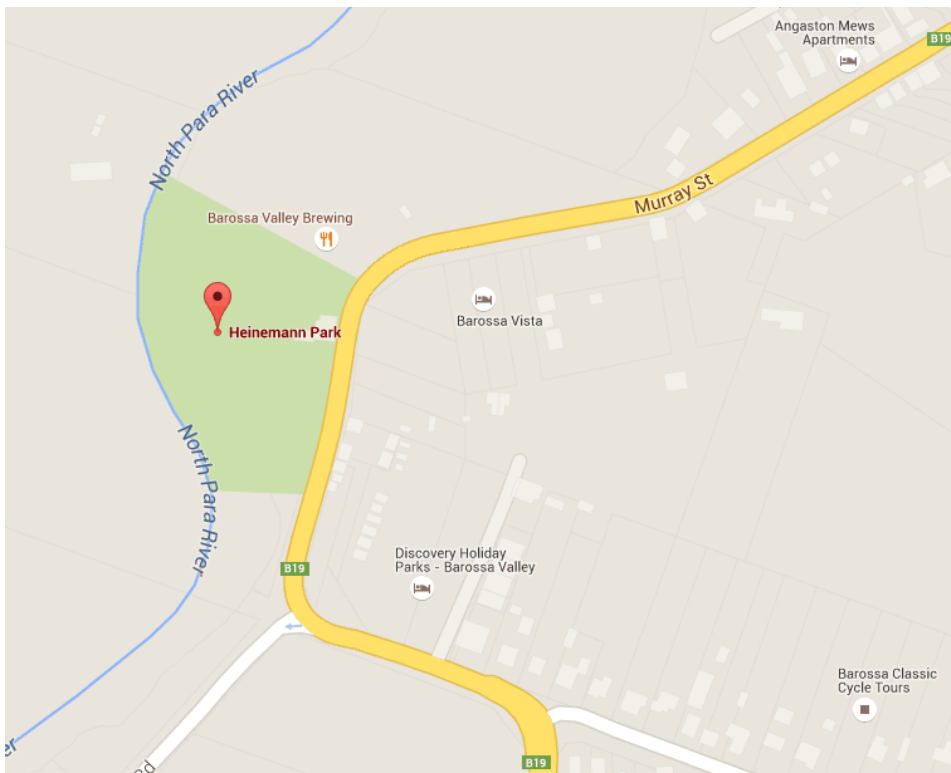
