20th Anniversary Indoor Crossbow Event.

Invitation.

The executive of the World Crossbow Shooting Association invites all members to participate in an Anniversary Indoor Postal Shoot to celebrate our 20 years as an association.

Timing: - September 16th and 17th 2023.

RULES OF COMPETITION.

The competition will be decided by the results of:

Two TC600/18/40 Indoor rounds, each comprising 60 competition bolts at 18m on a World Archery/FITA licenced 40cm three spot vertical strip multi coloured 5 zone face. Medieval shooters shall use the full coloured 10 zone 40cm target face.

Rounds may be shot on either day or the same day. The competition must be a registered WCSA STAR EVENT and must be registered at least 7 days prior to the start of competition. A copy of the registration form is attached.

There will only be Individual competition for Target, Standard, Freestyle, and Medieval crossbow.

Entry is open to all WCSA affiliated Individuals, Clubs and Federations covering the Target, Standard, Freestyle and Medieval crossbow divisions for Men, Women, Senior 55+, Senior 70+, Juniors (under18 years) and Assisted categories.

Scoring:

The double scoring system must be used. This means that there must be a shooter's version and a witness's version of each score sheet for each round.

You must use Score Sheet 5, published "Full Indoor Score Card" on the "Competition and Shooting Rules" page of the WCSA website. A copy of the scorecard is attached.

As WCSA does not have a universal electronic scoring system paper scoring must be used.

Entry Fee:

This event is a 20th Anniversary celebration event and is FREE to enter.

Making an Entry:

Each entrant is only permitted one entry.

Entries may only be made by a members Federation. Where a country does not have a Federation, a club or individual may submit their own entry provided the correct shooting conditions are met.

Before a tournament takes place send a Tournament Registration Form (at least 7 days prior) to the WCSA Recorder and Technical Officer.

At the completion of the event.

An Entry must include:

- 1. Event Verification form. (Copy attached)
- 2. Results sheet. (Copy attached)
- 3. Shooter's score sheets for every individual.
- 4. Witness's score sheets for every individual.

All information to be sent electronically as pdf files.

Entries must be sent by email to reach the Recorder and Technical officer not later than 1st October 2023.

All entries will receive a participation certificate and the winner of each division will receive a WCSA commemorative coin.

As this event will be a registered WCSA Star Event all score will be applied to the entrants world ranking.
