Subject: Amendments to Prone/Bench Crossbow shooting Rules,  
effective 1st February 2012

A couple of items in the BPR600/70 rules were brought to the attention of the Technical Committee as needing some alterations.

We have investigated and as a subsequence made amendments to the following clauses.

42.1 Range Layout - amended butt height and size

42.1.4,  
42.1.5,  
42.1.6,  
42.1.11

42.2 Venue Equipment - amended butt height and size

42.1.1,  
42.2.3,  
42.2.5,  
42.2.6

42.9 Shooting Position - amended all clauses

This now permits shooting from almost any position in either Prone or Bench. A shooter may now either have the crossbow fully supported or only supported at the front and use the shoulder with the prone or bench position, but they must be laying on the ground in the prone and seated on a seat in the Bench position to shoot.

The amended sections are in red in the rules update and are effective as from 1st February 2012
