PLEASE NOTE;
Change of Round for the SPORTING CROSSBOW in Outdoor Target and Matchplay.

The WCSA have updated the Rules for Sporting Crossbow Target which has changed the round for target from the SC900 to an **SC600**

The SC600 consists of:

60 bolts – 20 at each distance of 55m, 45m, 35m on 60 cm face = total score of 600

comprising:

10 ends of 2 bolts shot in 3 minutes (90 seconds per bolt) at 55m = 20 bolts, (max score 200)

10 ends of 2 bolts shot in 3 minutes (90 seconds per bolt) at 45m = 20 bolts, (max score 200)

10 ends of 2 bolts shot in 3 minutes (90 seconds per bolt) at 35m = 20 bolts, (max score 200)

The Matchplay now consists of:

Each Match

3 ends of 2 bolts shot in 3 minutes (90 seconds per bolt) at 45m = 6 bolts, (max score 60)

We understand this has been done to allow better time for loading Sporting Crossbows which require a loading device.

UPDATED FOREST ROUND

The WCSA has also updated the FOREST ROUND. Please check the updated rules on the web. The updated Forest Round Shooting Rules in the Sporting Crossbow Rules also apply to Target Crossbow.

Target Crossbow please note that your bolts must be numbered for shooting the Forest Round.

Look forward to your entering the Championships and welcoming you to Western Australia.
