

World Crossbow Shooting Association Inc.

Guidelines for Scoring and Award Claims at All registered WCSA Championships.

Effective as of 1st January 2022

These guidelines have been compiled to provide additional information for all World Crossbow Shooting Association (WCSA) crossbow members and should be read in conjunction with the latest World Crossbow Shooting Association - Shooting Rules.

The WCSA Shooting rules and these Scoring and Award Claims Guidelines refer specifically to all approved registered WCSA events. Each Federation may operate under their own local rules and regulations and that is a matter for those individual Federation and their members.

Scoring.

WCSA have a series of Standard Scorecards for Target, Indoor, Matchplay, Forest / Bushland which are available on the WCSA website. It is recommended that the appropriate scorecards be used for every shoot regardless of it being a championship or club shoot. Regularly using the WCSA standard scorecards will ensure that all shooters are aware of the layout of the scorecards and all information required to be entered on the scorecards.

For major events the Organising committee may insert the Event Name and Event Logo to the scorecard (if applicable). The Organising committee may also fill in some preliminary information for you and this should always be checked to ensure it is correct.

It is very important that you as the shooter fill out all the information required on the scorecard/s. For all WCSA registered events double scoring is mandatory.

Required information. (refer Correct and Incorrect scorecards in Appendix 1 and 2.

Your scorecard details.

Surname, Given Name, Round, Country, Target Number, Date, Bow Type and Division.

Your scoring details.

Distances to be shot, Bolt Scores, Bolt End Score, Progressive Score.

If an incorrect bolt score is accidently entered then a Judge must be called to adjudicate, change the entry, and sign the scorecard in Red.

Completing your scorecard.

Distance Ring 10's, Distance All 10's and Distance Total Scores.

Total Hits, Total Ring 10's, Total All 10's, Total Score.

Signature of shooter, Signature of witness

and any Award claim/s you made have earned.

It is the responsibility of you the shooter to check your scorecard/s before signing them. Having signed your scorecard/s, you have accepted the scorecard/s and it can not be altered in anyway after you sign it.

Any scorecard submitted for inclusion in an Event Results List and found to be missing any information may be rejected and or discarded.

Award Claims.

The World Crossbow Shooting Association provides awards for scores achieved at approved registered WCSA championships. These include World Championship Records, World Records, Regional Championship Records, Regional Records, Team Records and WCSA Star Badges. Star Badges attract a fee and details are available from the Financial Officer.

All Record claims must be submitted to the WCSA Recorder by email (but if this is not possible the claim maybe submitted by post) for processing.

Any Claim must be received by the WCSA Recorder within 15 working days following the competition.

All claims must include the following information.

Verification from your Federation, Event Registration confirmation, both completed Scorecards and the Event Results sheet. This information maybe scanned for submission via email.

Any claim made that does not include all of the above information may be returned to the Federation for correction and the corrected claim must be received by the WCSA Recorder within 7 days of the sent date or may be rejected.
