7th World Prone / Bench / Kneeling Crossbow Championships by Email

INVITATION

Timing: 1st February to 31st October 2026

RULES OF COMPETITION.

Competition will be decided by the results of:

One Round of the following events.

Bench (Target, Standard and Freestyle) - BTC600/70/40

Prone (Target, Standard and Freestyle) – PTC600/70/40

Kneeling (Medieval Only) – KMC600/50/60

Each round will comprise 60 competition bolts at the required crossbow type distance on a World Archery licensed full 10 zone single target face as detailed for the crossbow type.

The rounds will be shot on different days or the same day at a WCSA REGISTERED STAR EVENT. This arrangement allows for competitors to enter several different disciplines – Target, Sport Standard, Sport Freestyle, or Medieval. If rounds are shot on different days they must be within a period of 30 days, i.e. if Event 1 takes place on 1st of the month, Event 2 may be no later 30th of that month.

Federations, Clubs and Individual member may schedule multiple events and submit the best round score for the competitors.

Due to the increase in the number of Divisions, a separate Individual Entry form is required for each bow Class.

WCSA STAR EVENTS must be registered 30 days prior to the start of competition and shall be listed on the WCSA shooting calendar. A copy of the registration form is attached. The WCSA Recorder will confirm your registration by return email.

Verification form, Results sheets and a copy of both scoresheets from the individual claiming a record and must be sent to the Recorder for assessment of Rating, Regional and World Records within two weeks of completion of any Event. This does not constitute a Championship Entry.

There will be both Club and Federation Team competitions for Target, Standard, Freestyle, and Medieval crossbow. Each Federation may enter up to five (5) MIXED teams, refer to Book 2 – clause 11.2. Each Club may enter one (1) MIXED team. Each team will comprise three (3) shooters with all shooters in a team using the same type of equipment. Para combined teams will comprise two (2) shooters. Teams do not have to be announced before shooting has been completed.

Entry is open to all WCSA affiliated Federations, clubs and individuals covering both the Target, Freestyle, Standard and Medieval crossbow divisions for Men, Women, Senior, Senior70+, Intermediate, Junior, Para 1, and Para 2 categories.

Scoring:

The double scoring system must be used. This means that there must be a shooter's version and a witness version of each score sheet for each round. These must be retained by the Federation as scanned data.

You must use published scoresheet "60 Bolt scorecard - Indoor or Bench Prone Kneeling" on the "Competition and Shooting Rules" page of the WCSA web site. Score values must be entered as numerals. Any letter will be taken to indicate a miss – that is no score. A Ring Ten must be recorded as a 10 with a circle drawn around it. We are aware that there are electronic scoring systems available, but at present WCSA do not have a single universal system. Therefore, double paper score sheets must be used.

Awards: Gold, silver and bronze WCSA medals in each class for both Individual and Mixed Team competition. WCSA Star badges may be claimed via your federation Secretary. Refer to the Star Event and Rating Policy for order process.

Registration and Entry: PLEASE READ THIS CAREFULLY

Before a tournament takes place, complete a Tournament Registration form and email it to the Recorder and the Web master at least 30 days before the event. A confirmation email must be received from the Recorder prior the start of a competition.

On completion of the tournament, complete and send the Event Verification Form, Results sheet and copies of both the individual scoresheets for any record claims to the Recorder and the Web Master within 14 days of the end of the tournament.

Postal Championship Entries may only be made by a member Federation. Where a country does not have a Federation. An affiliated Club or individual may make their own entry provided the correct shooting conditions as stated in the WCSA competition and Shooting Rules are met.

The Postal Championship Entry is to be submitted only after the completion of the registered tournaments within the time frame of 1st February to 31st October 2026.

A Postal Championship Entry must include:

1. Individual Entry Form(s) (check that every field is correct). You need a separate form for each bow classification.
2. Team Entry Form (check that every field is correct)
3. Postal Championships Result sheet. This sheet must list the best score shot in a double round by each competitor. The scores to be listed are from the registered competitions conducted within the competition dates listed.

Do not send any Postal Championship entries until all shooting has been completed and verified by your Federation, Club or Individual official.

Do Not send any Postal Championship entries before 1st November 2026.

All information to be sent electronically as pdf files to the Recorder.

Postal Championship Entries must be sent by e-mail to reach the Recorder not later than 30th November 2026.

Entry fees must be sent to the WCSA bank account (refer details above) using the name on the Individual competitor as reference for the Financial Officer not later than 30th November 2026.
