Location and venue



11th World Target Championship venue.

The historic region of the Barossa Valley (population approx. 26,000) is located approximately 80 km (50 miles) northeast of Adelaide in the state of South Australia. The name Barossa honours the memory of the “Battle of Barrosa”, a Spanish battleground where the British defeated the French.

The Barossa Archery Club at Archery Road, Tanunda has a Target Range, Field Courses, and a modest clubhouse. All the events will be conducted at the Rowland Flat Aero Model Club grounds at Rowland Flat.

Travel and local transport

The nearest international airport is in Adelaide. It is recommended to fly directly into Adelaide because in Australia, international arrivals must clear customs at the first arrival point.

Participants are advised to clear Customs at Adelaide Airport rather than other Australian airports due to legal requirements. Taking crossbows over state borders can present problems.

It is strongly advisable to hire a vehicle as there is no public transport available to or in the Barossa Valley.

Note: Australians drive on the left-hand side of the road.

Please note that Australia has extremely strict quarantine regulations. You will need to declare your crossbow and all wooden / timber items including tackle boxes and bolts. Feathers can also present problems if not declared. Read the Declaration Form carefully.

Legal issues

Crossbows are Prohibited Weapons in all Australian States and Territories. We will organise **IMPORT PERMITS** on your behalf from the information you provide in the Final Entry form and send your permit with any additional information to you prior to your travel. To ensure there are no delays in providing the permits please send in your entry as early as possible.

It is not advisable to take a crossbow across State borders as all states have different licensing arrangements. If you are planning to travel interstate while in Australia, please consult with the Organising committee regarding your plans and your equipment.

5. **Your Travel details** are required to allow us to inform the relevant authorities when to expect your arrival with your crossbow. This should help in a smoother passage through customs with your crossbow.
Remember to mark your arrival card indicating that you are bringing a prohibited weapon into Australia.
ALL your incoming baggage is X-rayed on arrival so do not try to hide it or any other items.
Penalties are very severe.
6. **Accommodation details** are required so we can contact you should it be necessary. It is also required for your permit.
7. **A Wind-up Function/Banquet** is being organised for the Monday night 24th at the Harvest Kitchen at the Jacobs Creek Centre following the completion of the Bushland round and presentations. Please indicate if you plan on attending the banquet and how many others may be accompanying you (Wife, Partner, Children, Friends etc.) This will give us an idea of how many the venue may have to cater for.
8. Approved participants who withdraw prior to the 1st of Feb 2025 will be refunded less a 50% administration fee. After this date no refund will be issued.
